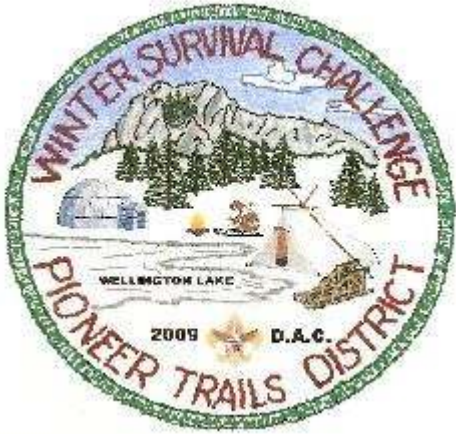

Dear Troop 88,

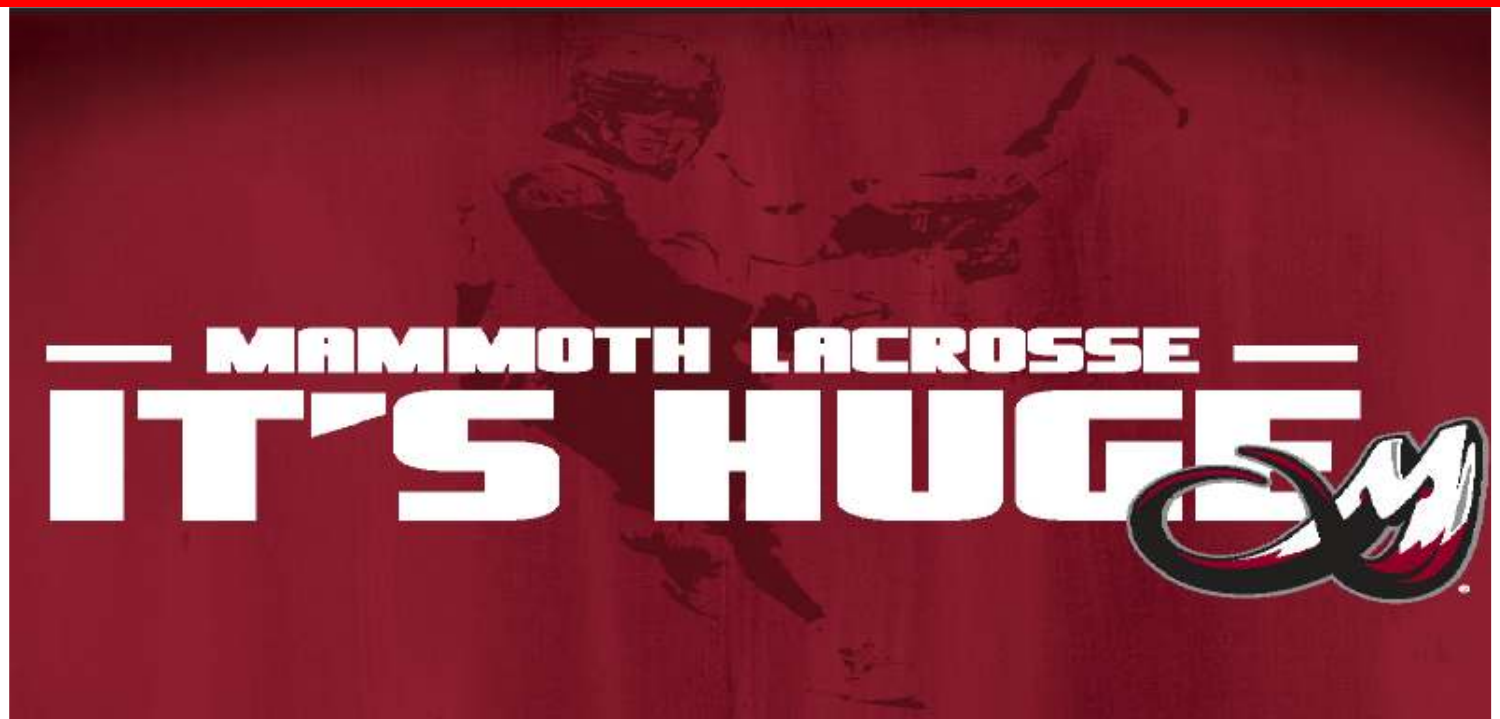

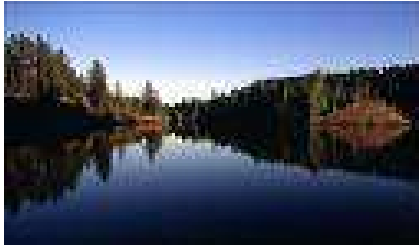
