Troop 88 Scouts and Adults. The Troop will be hosting a booth at this year's scout show to be held April 24th at the National Western Stock Show Pavilion.

In keeping with this year's theme of celebrating the 100th anniversary of scouting we will be demonstrating how to "hand-build" hiking staves. Stave designs on display will range from those suitable to be built and used by a Cub-Scout through to Adults. There will be posters throughout the booth and a handout that provide design ideas.

Scouts and adult members of Troop 88 who sign up to participate in our booth will have the opportunity to start building their own hiking staves. Each stave is different, depending on what you choose to include so it's hard to determine how long it will take to complete what you want. The best part is that you can build a very basic stave now and add to it as time goes on. A basic stave will include the stick (\$8), footing and cap (\$5) and a grip (\$3). From there you can add a variety of things including tools, carvings, and medallions, the sky and your imagination is the limit.

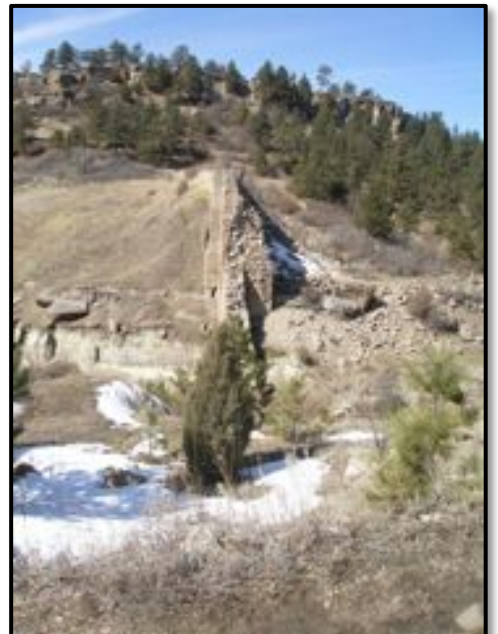
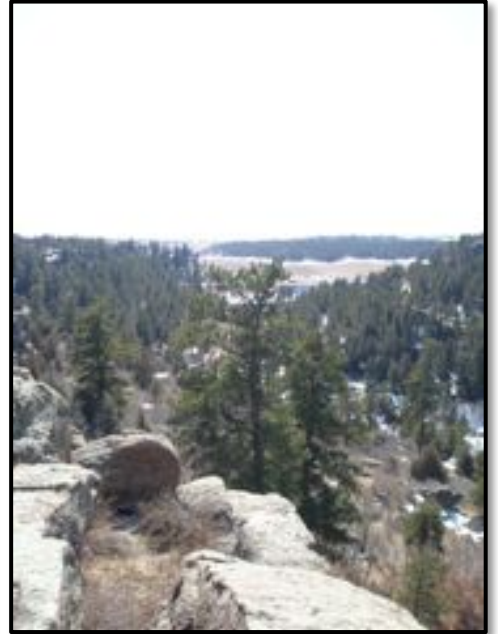
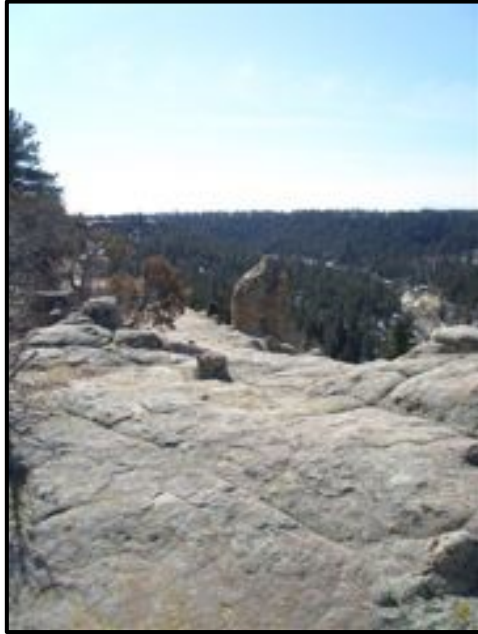

I do need your support, including adults, but we need to limit attendance to no more than 3 scouts and an adult in each hourly time slot; otherwise there will be too many people in our 10'x10' space.

The sign-up sheet will ask if you wish to build a hiking stick and if you want to bring your own materials or have me provide them. If you are going to have me provide materials I would like \$16 to cover the costs.
