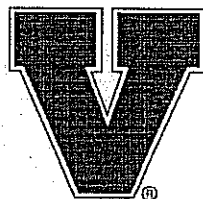

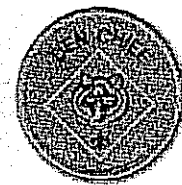
## Commissioners

## Youth Leaders

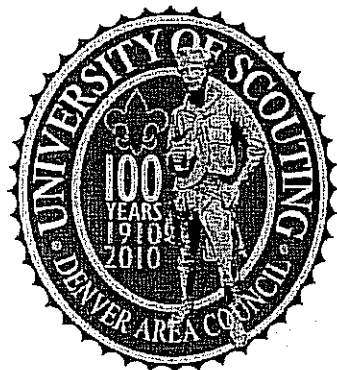

## Day Care/Day Camp

Scouting is a family program. Day Care will be available for those families with younger children. Day Care/Camp attendees must be at least 3 years old and POTTY TRAINED. There will be age/gender appropriate activities for your child while you attend training.
