

# Yellowstone – 2021 Itinerary

Updated: February 22, 2021

- 1) Saturday, July 24<sup>th</sup> – Depart Parker for Yellowstone @ 7:00 AM. Eat breakfast before you leave and lunch/dinner will be provided on the way (fast-food @ Casper (lunch) & Cody (early-dinner)). Anticipated 10-hour travel time (not including meal stops) and arrive early evening at Bridge Bay Campground. Partial set-up of camp in evening.
- 2) Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup> – Finish set-up of camp in the morning. Explore area (Fishing Bridge, Mud Volcano and West Thumb) in afternoon. Breakfast, lunch & dinner in camp.
- 3) Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> – Merit badge work time (AM block and PM block). Breakfast, lunch & dinner in camp.
- 4) Tuesday, July 27<sup>th</sup> – Old Faithful and surrounding area (like Grand Prismatic Spring & Morning Glory Pool). Breakfast and dinner in camp with lunch in a picnic area (on the road).
- 5) Wednesday, July 28<sup>th</sup> – Merit badge work time (AM block and PM block). Breakfast, lunch & dinner in camp.
- 6) Thursday, July 29<sup>th</sup> – Canyon area and Lamar Valley area. Breakfast and dinner in camp with lunch in a picnic area (on the road).
- 7) Friday, July 30<sup>th</sup> – Firehole river (swimming) and Mammoth area. Breakdown majority of camp in late-afternoon/early-evening. Breakfast and dinner in camp with lunch in a picnic area (on the road).
- 8) Saturday, July 31<sup>st</sup> – Depart Yellowstone for Parker @ 9:00 AM. Anticipated 10-hour travel time return to Parker. Cold (quick) breakfast at campground before departure with lunch/dinner provided on the way (fast food).
- 9) Group site parking (3-vehicles and the troop trailer counts at a vehicle) – Discussion of individual tent site reservations for parking and families.
- 10) Cost – Currently estimated at \$500 per person. Will finalize troop cost at end of trip with difference going into scout account. Deposit (50%) needed by 03/15 to participate.
